****If you are in danger, call 9-1-1 right away****

- **NJ 211:** If you are an NJ resident experiencing a crisis, call **2-1-1** or [click here](#) to get connected with various social services in your community.
- **Domestic Violence:** If you or someone you know is living in fear of intimate partner violence, call the [New Jersey Domestic Violence Hotline](#) at **1-800-572-SAFE (7233)**.
- **Sexual Assault:** If you have been affected by sexual assault, call the [New Jersey Coalition Against Sexual Assault Hotline](#) at **1-800-601-7200** for assistance and referrals. You will be connected to the closest rape crisis care center.
- **Drug or Alcohol Addiction:** For assistance and a referral to treatment, call the [NJ Addiction Services Hotline](#) at **1-844-276-2777**
 - Is your family member or friend living with a substance use disorder? Call [NJ Connect for Recovery](#) at **1-855-652-3737**
- **Veterans:** If you are a Veteran in crisis or are concerned about one, call the [Veterans Crisis Line](#) at **800-273-8255** and press 1 or **text 838255**
 - No matter what you are experiencing or what questions you have, you can call the [Veterans Counseling Hotline](#) at **1-866-VETS-NJ4 (1-866-838-7654)** to connect immediately with a support specialist who is prior military.

 - Youth through age 25 should call the [LGBT National Youth Hotline](#) at **800-246-7743**
- **Suicide:** Those who may be having suicidal thoughts should call **1-855-NJ-HOPELINE (855-654-6735)**.
